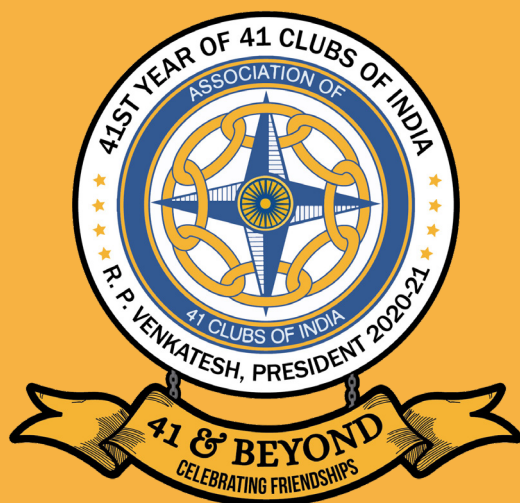
Hope this message finds you all in good health and cheer this holiday season.

- **Club Charter days** are celebrated as it is the year of 41 & Beyond, Celebrating Friendships.

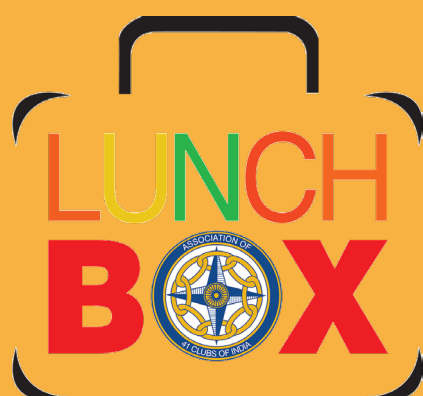
- **4 Associations 1 Family** – 41 India, RT India, Tangent India & LC India. To maintain good interactions with these associations to strengthen each other.

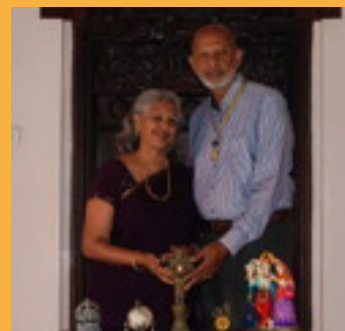
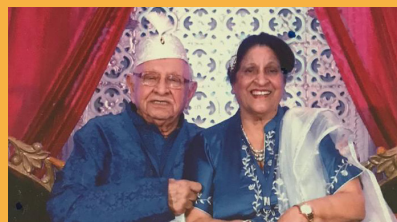

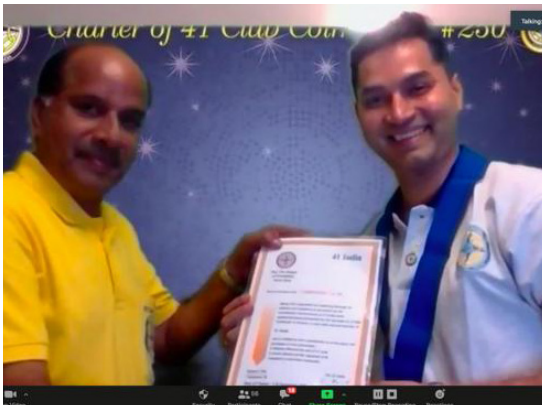

"About 60 members attending Club 38's extension of Club 250 has become an event of history..."



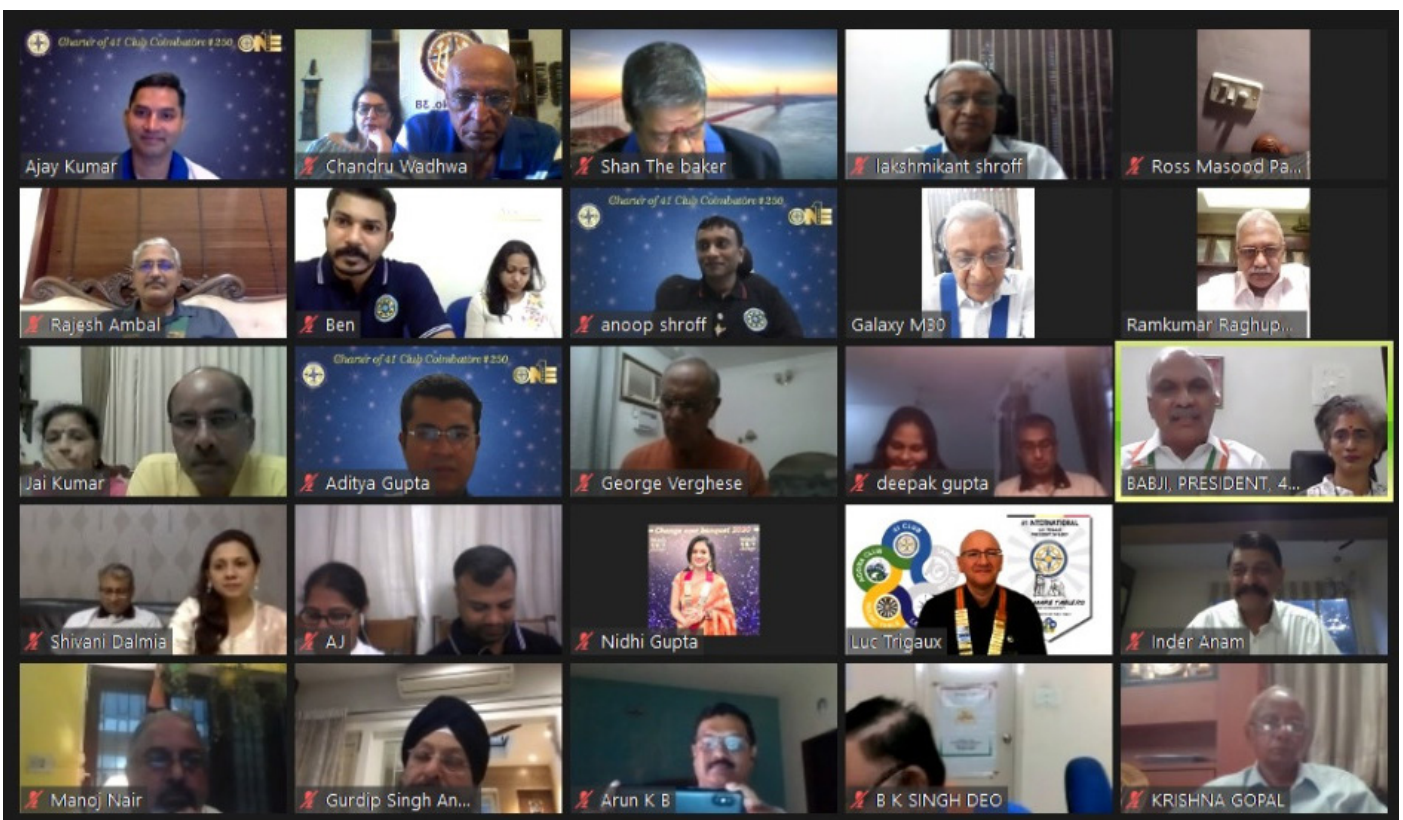

10 YEARS & BEYOND



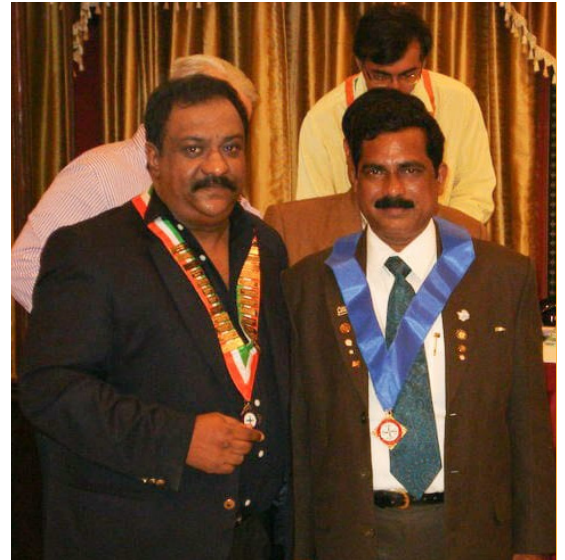
On this 10th year of Charter of our Pondicherry Elite 41 Club No: 139, I salute all the Past Presidents of 41 Clubs India for their support and guidance.

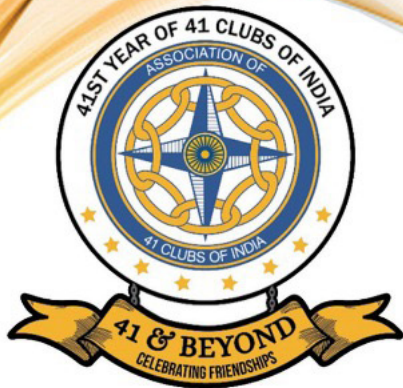
